

UPDATE CONCERNING LAKE REMEDIATION EFFORTS

Dear Lake Arrowhead Neighbor:

As you may know, the Board of Trustees for Lake Arrowhead Club, Inc. ("LAC") has been planning to perform hydro raking of the lakes for some time. As described to members in past meetings of the board, the Lakes Committee has developed a remediation plan that entails, among other things, the planned hydro raking of each lake. The plan is and has been to remediate the Bay of Deep Waters ("BDW") first, and then move in a westerly direction (the direction of flow of the lakes) to perform hydro raking in Great Bay, followed by Lake Arrowhead. Given the time and large expense involved, as well as the need to construct a means for ingress for each of the lakes that will accommodate the equipment involved, these plans involve a multi-year effort. We will also continue with yearly treatments of the three lakes and the Forest Pond.

The Board is pleased to inform you that hydro raking for BDW has been scheduled to commence on or about April 30, 2018 and to continue there for approximately ten working days, weather permitting. The work is the culmination of months of planning and close coordination with municipal and state regulators to ensure compliance with local and state laws and permitting requirements. BDW will be accessed at an entry point constructed on LAC land last year. The waste removed from the lakes will be recycled in an environmentally friendly manner, and the contractors will be working in a manner that will take great care not to disturb the environment any more than is absolutely necessary to perform the work.
